



2009/2010 Wet Weather Information

In cases of wet weather, local councils may choose to close the grounds under their control. In these circumstances, competition games will be cancelled and possibly re-scheduled to a later date.

HOME TEAMS

Team managers will be contacted by a Thornleigh Baseball Club committee member as soon as possible if Home competition games are washed out. Team managers will then be responsible for contacting their team members and the opposition coach/manager to advise that the game has been washed out.

AWAY TEAMS

If there is doubt about whether a game is still on Team managers are to contact the opposition team's contact in the competition draw to ascertain if the game has been cancelled. If the game has been washed out the manager will inform all members of their team.

WASH OUTS DURING A GAME

If the game has already commenced when it starts raining, the umpire will be responsible for calling the game off because of safety or other reasons.

TRAINING SESSIONS

Hornsby Shire Council may close our grounds during the week and training on fields which have been closed by council is **not allowed**. Offenders may be liable to fines, it is dangerous for players and may damage the playing surface of the fields.

Where grounds have not been closed it is left to the coach/manager's discretion on whether scheduled training sessions will be held. It is important that the players' well being is considered first and foremost when deciding whether or not to hold training sessions.
