BIRTH CERTIFICATES:

Any new player registering **MUST** supply an original Birth Certificate, Extract thereof or passport for sighting by HDNA prior to the start of the season. Certificates are to be submitted by Grading day and will be held by the Secretary until after HDNA late Registration Day (18th March).

MODIFIED RULES: (7, 8 and 9 years):

Games for 7's & 8's are played at **Cheltenham Courts**, 9's play at **Pennant Hills Complex**. Modified teams must supply an **umpire** for their games. PARENT ASSISTANCE:

Please indicate on the registration form, where applicable, if you are willing to assist the club by managing, coaching or umpiring. Each team requires a manager over 16 to be registered by HDNA.

Anyone available for coaching, please contact **Clare Ashpole (94762054)**. Any senior player who coaches a Thornleigh Netball team will receive a 10% discount off their fees. All coaches must obtain their level 'O' Grade to coach. HDNA runs a Level 'O' Coaching Clinic. See Clare Ashpole for extra details.

Girls wishing to umpire need to be at least 13 years by the end of December 2009. Parents of younger girls (especially mothers who take part in Night Comp) are also needed to umpire. These duties are usually organised so that you umpire before or after you're own or your daughter's match. Coaching will be available for umpires. UNIFORMS:

INJURIES:

If an injury THAT REQUIRES MORE THAN FIRST AID TREATMENT occurs during the course of a netball game to a player or umpire they must notify HDNA of the injury as soon as possible. They will be given appropriate insurance forms that must be signed by a Hills official on the day. Any injured player requiring an ambulance but without Ambulance Insurance Cover must inform HDNA prior to the ambulance being called so appropriate cover can be arranged.

NETBALL MEETINGS:

One representative from each team **MUST** attend each meeting. Often this is the manager of the team however it is every team member's responsibility to ensure someone from the team is present at every meeting. Meetings are held on the third Monday of every month from March to September

2010 SEASON:

The 2010 Season will commence on Saturday 17th April 2010 and should finish on Saturday 4th September. However, if bad weather occurs during the finals the season may need to be extended.
