Welcome to the 2010 football Season. The registration process this year takes much the same form as last year. The main registration day will be on the Saturday 30th of January followed by three evening sessions at the Pennant Hills Bowling Club (See Below).

IMPORTANT PLEASE NOTE: This year it will again be possible to register by post BUT ONLY IF YOU PLAYED WITH THORNLEIGH LAST SEASON. If you choose to re-register by post you MUST include a cheque (for the correct amount) or Credit Card details (Master Card and Visa only). When paying by Credit Card you must fill out the Credit Card payment details on the bottom of the Fees form and include it with your application. You must sign an application form and complete and sign the insurance form that can be downloaded from the website (www.thornleighsports.org.au/soccer/soccermain.asp). If any of these items are incomplete or missing you will not be registered.

The fees for 2010 have increased slightly from 2009 to cover higher association costs and are shown on Fees and Payment Form. These can be paid by cash, cheque, or credit card (Visa or MasterCard only) on registration day. ***Please note: All players must pay their fees in full before the Club will register them (registration forms will not be accepted without payment of fees). Unregistered players are not permitted to play in any match for insurance reasons.***

Fees for 2010 again include one social membership (per family or one per senior player) to the Pennant Hills Bowling Club. The PHBC is one of the major sponsors of the Thornleigh Soccer and we encourage all families to take advantage of the membership and support the club. New families should complete a social membership application on registration day. If you are an existing member there is no need to fill out another form. Membership renewal occurs later in 2010 and the club will advise when this occurs.

In our continuing effort to ensure fees are kept to a minimum **socks and shorts are not included in the registration fees unless it is your first registration with the Thornleigh Club.** If you or your son/daughter requires a new pair of socks and/or shorts please order and pay for these at registration time.

Grading dates and times and a calendar of other important dates will also be published on the club's website during January. If a player cannot attend a grading session please contact a committee member before the session to make alternative arrangements. Please check the website for updates.

A change has been made to the TSC Application Form this year. There has been a provision added that states that by signing the form the Player/Parent agrees to abide by the Club and Association codes of conduct. The location of these codes can be found online at the websites indicated on the Application Form.

A final note - without the support of the local community the club would not be able to carry out all its activities. We therefore encourage parental involvement in the coaching and managing of all junior teams. If you do not feel that these roles are for you then there are other ways to become involved, for example, in the running of the club at the committee level. The Thornleigh Football Club is always seeking financial assistance through sponsorship from local businesses and if you feel you could help in this area please contact a committee member or indicate your interest on the registration form.

Thank you for your continued support and involvement with the club and remember being part of a soccer team with Thornleigh Thunder is not all about winning - it's about being involved and having fun.
